



The Dyslexia Outreach Service is running a half day course for parents/carers in the Harleston Cluster, there is a small group going from Pulham School, would you like to join them?

This course has been specifically designed for anyone who has contact with children of school age with dyslexia.

It would also benefit parents of pupils who experience literacy related difficulties without a specific diagnosis.

You do not need to know anything about literacy difficulties or dyslexia to do this course.

The course will cover

- how to help with homework
- how to support further reading and spelling development
- how to support difficulty with organisation and memory
- how to communicate with school

The training will be on Friday 8th December from 9:30 am to 1:00 pm, in the training room at Archbishop Sancroft High School. The course costs £25 and payment is requested in advance.

There are 12 places on this course and it is being offered to all 4 schools in the cluster. Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.
